

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- ❖ Please verify that this is your property. The township treasurer is not responsible for payments made on the wrong property and cannot transfer payments to or from any parcel or refund payments made on the wrong parcel.
- ❖ Please verify that your tax bill reflects the correct Principal Residence Exemption (PRE) percentage. **Residences owned and occupied with PRE affidavits filed on or before November 1, 2025 will show 100% PRE on your tax bill.** PRE corrections can be addressed by the Township Assessor. Please call the township at (734) 426-3767 on Wednesdays to talk to the Township Assessor with any questions regarding Principal Residence Exemptions.
- ❖ In 2025, the last day to pay summer taxes without incurring interest or penalty is **Monday, September 15, 2025 by 5:00 pm. (MCL 211.44)**
- ❖ Dexter Township office hours are 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM Monday – Thursday. **Township offices will be closed:** Monday, September 1, 2025.
- ❖ **PLEASE NOTE:** PNC will no longer collect tax payments on behalf of Dexter Township. Taxes can be paid in person at the town hall during business hours, by mailed check with remittance included, or by utilizing the blue, locked drop box outside of the town hall. *See additional payment options below. Your cancelled check is your receipt for payment of taxes. Date stamped receipts will be mailed upon request. Payment status of tax parcels can also be accessed at: www.dextertownshipmi.gov
- ❖ Electronic check payments made via Point and Pay are subject to a \$3.00 convenience fee for payments up to \$10,000.00 and \$10.00 for payments over \$10,000.00; credit card payments are subject to a 3% convenience fee (minimum \$2.00). - ❖ Dexter Township Treasurer is currently accepting applications for summer/winter tax deferments on principal residences. Forms are available at the township office, at: www.dextertownshipmi.gov, or call the township office at (734) 426-3767 to request a form by mail. To qualify, a household annual income cannot exceed \$40,000. The applicant(s) must also be one of the following (1) 62 years of age or older, including the unmarried surviving spouse of a person who was 62 years or older at the time of death. (2) paraplegic or quadriplegic, (3) an eligible Service person, Eligible Veteran, or their Eligible Widow or Widower, (4) Blind, (5) totally and Permanently Disabled. Those that farm agricultural real property may qualify if the gross receipts of agricultural or horticultural operation in the previous year or the average gross receipts for such operations in the previous three years is not less than the household income for the preceding calendar year.
- ❖ Dexter Township will accept partial payments on tax bills up to and including **Thursday, February 26, 2026 by 5:00 p.m.** After Thursday, February 26, 2026, unpaid real property taxes must be paid to the Washtenaw County Treasurer, P.O. Box 8645, Ann Arbor, MI, 48107 with additional interest & penalties as prescribed by law. (MCL 211.45 and MCL 211.78a)
