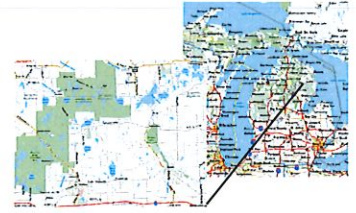

The Clerk along with Election Worker (Mielke) phoned all our Precinct #1 and Precinct #3P and 3D residents, who were on the Permanent Application, informing them that the State of Michigan plans to discontinue the Permanent Application and ask them if they would like to be moved to the Perm Ballot status. By making these calls we were able to significantly increase our voters to Perm Ballot status, ensuring our local voters that they will automatically receive their Absentee Voter Ballots for all future elections held at Dexter Township. Discussed how many applications and ballots had been sent out to date. The Clerk's office downloaded the tabulators, scans and touch writers with the current election.
